Our churches are doing well we have new people coming to Hilltop Baptist Church and Star's Sunday School class has grown to nine now. Some of these kids and family that visit regular are lost we pray that someday soon they will trust the Lord. Chayphruk Baptist is has new folks coming, and we are excited about what God is doing.

The lepers at Mai Lao are still asking for help, and there is little we can do for them right now until the Lord provides.
