


# New Life Ministries Thailand

Dear Pastor & Church

As you may have heard Thailand and Cambodia are fighting over an old temple on their border which both countries claim. Here where we are (400 miles to the North West) the gospel is still being preached, souls saved, and lives changed.

Over the years you may remember me mentioning one of our girls we call Star, she is the oldest and one of the first two girls we ever took in our home 6 years ago. Recently in her school class they had some free time so they were allowed to chat with each other. Star begins telling her friend how she had become a Christian, soon the whole class of kids had gathered around as Star took the opportunity to share the gospel with her entire class. I have told them over and over that when God opens a door, they should take advantage of it, she did.

We have had three new visitors coming regular to Chayphruk Baptist Church, it's my heart's desire that someday soon they will come to a realization of who God is and turn from their Buddhist belief, that gives them no hope to the only true God who can help them.

On February 2<sup>nd</sup> I turned 66 years old, God has been so good to us the past nine years since He has called us to Thailand, and no matter how long I live I will always know that these have been the best years of my life trying to get the gospel to the people of Northern Thailand.

The Rutledge Family is doing well on deputation, and has reached around 50% of their support. Their goal is to be on the field with us by January of 2012. I have had a lot of pastors who have asked me lately how much support we have now, and they seemed shocked when I tell them. For our Children's Home and other ministries there we have about \$2200 a month which all goes through our local church in Riceville, TN. Our kids have never missed a day of school or missed a meal. Then our personal support for the last 5 years has not changed and stands at \$700 a month. Pastors look at me and ask how in the world we operate, and I only have one answer...through "FAITH" that what He started He will keep supplied. I am taking this summer to try and increase the support for the ministry, there is so much more we would like to do, and could do. If you get this letter and do not support this ministry please pray about us coming this summer and share our burden for the Hill Tribe people of Thailand. If you do support this ministry thank you so much for your faithfulness you have made it all possible.
